The Odyssey

Character One-Pager

Due: Friday, September 29

Objective: You will demonstrate your understanding of the importance of characterization in *The Odyssey* through a one-pager activity.

Activity Instructions:

On the opposite side of this paper, you will create a one-pager that is both a visual and textual representation of one specific character in *The Odyssey*.

Your one-pager must include:

- /5 the title of the work- The Odyssey
- /5 the author's name- Homer
- /20 two quotes that illustrate the character well
 - these quotes must be cited by providing the author's last name and page number
 - ex. – "Put the quote in quotation marks" (Homer 868).
- /20 a creative, colorful illustration of the character depicted throughout the novel
 - you may use markers, colored pencils, magazine clippings, cut out colored paper
- /10 color/effort/neatness
a complete covering of the page (there should be **LITTLE-TO-NO** blank space)
conventions: grammar/usage/spelling/capitalization/punctuation
- /40 an **insightful, quality personal response** to the character (see below for guidelines)

A **QUALITY personal response** includes the following:

- at least five (5) sentences
- an analysis of the indirect characterization/direct characterization used in the passage
 - How does the characterization in the passage convey parts of the character's personality?
 - What does the description of the character remind you of? (Personal Connections)
- Exemplary** responses:
 - blend in textual evidence to illustrate your point
 - are free of conventional errors
 - reflect deep thought and analysis of the character's personality
 - go above and beyond the minimum requirements
